## Body, Disability and Social Position: an indicative approach to Disability habitus in Argentina

## Abstract:

All the corporal experience symbolic manipulations are manipulations over the body that reveal the position within the social space, that are reproduced within de physical space; we can check how this dispossession is embodied (Bourdieu, 1991:134). So, using Bourdieu words, we can assert that in a society divided in "classes all agent products speak inseparably about an essential overdetermination of him/her class". Our work hypothesis is that the possession of a disability produce a symbolic capital dispossession in general terms that crystalizes in social space low steps, and is translated in limitations for physical space and own body possibilities of manipulation (Bourdieu, 1991). Concretely, we analyse in this work the position within the social space of people with disabilities collective in Argentina, using the ENDI data, with the goal of observing in what measure the possession of a disability influences the occupied position in social space.
